The Texas Election Code, Sec. Sec. 3.001. ORDER REQUIRED. Each general and special election shall be ordered as provided by this chapter.

Sec. 3.006. CONTENTS OF ELECTION ORDER. In addition to any other elements required to be included in an election order by other law, each election order must state the date of the election and the offices or measures to be voted on at the election.

For Electing Council Place 5 (North Side At-Large) and Council Place 6 (South Side At-Large)

THIS CONTRACT IS ENTERED INTO BETWEEN TAYLOR COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR, KRISTI ALLYN, HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS ADMINISTRATOR, AND THE CITY OF ABILENE, HEREINAFTER REFRRED TO AS CITY, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS CITY COUNCIL, PURSUANT TO TEX. ELEC. CODE ANN., SEC. 31.091, WITNESSETH:

- 1. **RECITALS.** THE ADMINISTRATOR IS THE COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, AND IS THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF ELECTION DUTIES. THE CITY IS A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SITUATED PARTIALLY WITHIN TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS. THE CITY AND THE ADMINISTRATOR HAVE DETERMINED THAT IT IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE CITY THAT THE ADMINISTRATOR FURNISH TO THE CITY CERTAIN ELECTION SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT NEEDED IN CONNECTION WITH THE HOLDING OF THE ELECTION ON **MAY 11, 2013.** THIS CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WILL BE BINDING UPON THE PARTIES WITH REGARD TO THIS ELECTION ONLY. ELECTRONIC VOTING EQUIPMENT IS TO BE USED.
- 2. <u>DUTIES AND SERVICES OF ADMINISTRATOR.</u> THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PERFORMING THE FOLLOWING DUTIES AND SHALL FURNISH THE FOLLOWING SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT:
- (A) PREPARE LIST OF PERSONS TO RECOMMEND FOR APPOINTMENT AS PRESIDING ELECTION JUDGES, ALTERNATE JUDGES, MANAGER OF CENTRAL COUNTING, TABULATION SUPERVISOR, JUDGE OF CENTRAL COUNTING STATION, JUDGE OF EARLY BALLOT BOARD AND ASSISTANTS; RECRUIT AND TRAIN THE JUDGES AND CLERKS; AND CONFIRM JUDGES AND POLLING PLACES.
 - (B) DISTRIBUTE ELECTION SUPPLIES.
- (C) ASSEMBLE AND EDIT LISTS OF REGISTERED VOTERS TO BE USED IN CONDUCTING THE ELECTION, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY AND THE ELECTION PRECINCTS ESTABLISHED FOR THE ELECTION.
- (D) PREPARE AND DISTRIBUTE ELECTION EQUIPMENT, AND ISSUE ELECTION SUPPLIES TO THE PRECINCT JUDGES, WHO SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP ELECTION SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS AT THE TIME AND PLACE DETERMINED BY THE ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR.
- (E) ARRANGE FOR USE OF A CENTRAL COUNTING STATION AND FOR THE TABULATING PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT NEEDED AT THE COUNTING STATION AND PREPARE PROGRAMS AND TEST MATERIALS FOR TABULATION OF THE BALLOTS TO BE USED WITH ELECTRONIC VOTING EQUIPMENT.
- (F) PUBLISH LEGAL NOTICE OF THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF THE TESTING OF THE ELECTRONIC TABULATING EQUIPMENT AND CONDUCT SUCH TESTING.
- (G) SUPERVISE THE HANDLING AND DISPOSITION OF ELECTION RETURNS; VOTED BALLOTS; TABULATE UNOFFICIAL RETURNS AND ASSIST IN PREPARING THE TABULATION FOR THE OFFICIAL CANVASS.
 - (H) PROVIDE INFORMATION SERVICES FOR VOTERS AND ELECTION OFFICERS.
- (I) ASSIST IN PROVIDING GENERAL OVERALL SUPERVISION OF THE ELECTION AND PROVIDE ADVISORY SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE DECISIONS TO BE MADE AND ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN BY OFFICERS OF THE CITY WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR HOLDING THE ELECTION.
- (J) PROVIDE TO THE CITY TIMELY CUMULATIVE REPORTS OF THE ELECTION RESULTS AS PRECINCTS ARE TABULATED.
- (K) SUPERVISE THE CONDUCT OF EARLY VOTING IN PERSON AND BY MAIL AND SUPPLY PERSONNEL TO SERVE AS DEPUTY EARLY VOTING CLERKS.
- (L) PROCESS ALL APPLICATIONS FOR EARLY VOTING BALLOTS BY MAIL, INCLUDING THOSE RECEIVED BY THE CITY. CITY SHALL TRANSPORT SUCH REQUESTS ON THE DAY OF RECEIPT TO THE OFFICE OF THE TAYLOR COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR FOR PROCESSING. PERSONS VOTING BY MAIL WILL SEND THEIR MARKED BALLOTS TO THE OFFICE OF THE TAYLOR COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR.
- (M) ARRANGE FOR PERSONNEL, PLACE, AND TIME FOR ALL EARLY VOTING BALLOTS (THOSE CAST BY MAIL AND THOSE CAST BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE) TO BE PREPARED FOR TABULATION BY AN EARLY VOTING BALLOT BOARD.

- (N) ARRANGE FOR PERSONNEL AND CONDUCT MANUAL COUNT, IF WAIVER IS NOT OBTAINED BY THE CITY.
 - (O) CONDUCT CANDIDATE DRAWING FOR BALLOT PLACEMENT
- (P) PROVIDE THE SERVICES NECESSARY TO TRANSLATE ANY ELECTION DOCUMENTS INTO SPANISH.
 - (Q) PROCURE, PREPARE, AND PROOF OFFICIAL AND SAMPLE BALLOT PAGES.
- (R) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYMENT TO ALL PARTIES WHO HAVE PROVIDED SERVICES, SUPPLIES AND VOTING LOCATIONS FOR THE ELECTION.
- (S) PROCURE ALL ELECTION SUPPLIES, INCLUDING ELECTION DAY AND EARLY VOTING KITS, JUDGES BOOTH CONTROLLERS, DISABLED ACCESS UNITS AND E-SLATES
- (T) ARRANGE FOR SUPPLIES TO BE DELIVERED TO TAYLOR COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE, 400 OAK STREET, SUITE 101, ABILENE, TEXAS 79602.
 - (U) PAY ALL PERSONNEL FROM PAYROLL SHEETS COLLECTED BY ADMINISTRATOR.

3. **DUTIES AND SERVICES OF CITY.** THE CITY SHALL:

- (A) PREPARE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS FOR ESTABLISHING THE PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES.
- (B) PREPARE ALL ELECTION ORDERS, WRITS, RESOLUTIONS, NOTICES, AND OTHER PERTINENT DOCUMENTS FOR ADOPTION FOR EXECUTION BY THE APPROPRIATE OFFICER OR BODY, AND TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY UNDER LAW FOR CALLING THE ELECTION, APPOINT THE PRESIDING JUDGES, ALTERNATE JUDGES, MANAGER OF CENTRAL COUNTING, TABULATION SUPERVISOR, JUDGE OF THE CENTRAL COUNTING STATION, JUDGE OF EARLY BALLOT BOARD AND ASSISTANTS AND OTHER ELECTION OFFICERS, ESTABLISH PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES, HANDLE CONTESTS, CANVASS THE RETURNS AND DECLARE THE RESULTS.
- (C) PREPARE ALL WRITTEN ELECTION NOTICES FOR PUBLISHING IN THE OFFICIAL CITY NEWSPAPER FOR ADMINISTRATOR. CITY SHALL POST WRITTEN NOTICES AT CITY HALL.
- (D) PRIOR TO ELECTION DAY THE CITY WILL PROVIDE TO ADMINISTRATOR THE NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF AN AGENT TO REPRESENT THE CITY. AGENT TO BE ON CALL TO THE ELECTIONS OFFICE DURING THE HOURS OF THE ELECTION.
- (E) PAY ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS INCURRED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR IF A RECOUNT FOR SAID ELECTION IS REQUIRED, OR THE ELECTION IS CONTESTED IN ANY MANNER.
- (F) PREPARE ANY SUBMISSION OF VOTING CHANGES TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE UNDER THE FEDERAL VOTING RIGHTS ACT OF 1965, AS AMENDED.
 - (G) APPROVE THE PRINTING OF MAIL AND SAMPLE BALLOT PAGES.
- (H) REQUEST WAIVER FOR MANUAL COUNT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SEC. 127.201 OF THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE, IF NECESSARY.

4. **PAYMENT OF SERVICES:**

CITY SHALL PAY TOTAL ACTUAL EXPENSES OF THE ELECTION PLUS A 10% ADMINISTRATIVE FEE BASED ON THEIR AGREED SHARE OF THE EXPENSES. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES SHALL BE STATED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT A, INCORPORATED HEREIN FOR ALL PURPOSES. RUNOFF ELECTION SHALL BE TREATED AS A SEPERATE ELECTION.

- (A) IN THE ELECTION ON **MAY 11, 2013,** COVERED BY THIS AGREEMENT, THE ADMINISTRATOR'S SERVICES SHALL BE AS STATED HEREIN.
- (B) IN THE EVENT OF ANY DISAGREEMENT AMONG SAID PARTIES CONCERNING SAID MECHANICAL AND/OR PROCEDURAL DETAILS OF THE PREPARATION FOR OR CONDUCT OF SAID ELECTION, SUCH DISAGREEMENT OR QUESTION SHALL BE RESOLVED BY FOLLOWING THE METHOD OR PROCEDURE FAVORED BY THE MAJORITY OF SAID PARTIES.
 - (C) PAYMENT FOR SERVICES SHALL BE AS STATED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT A.

SUBJECT: Oral Resolution – Authorizing the City Manager to sign an Agreement between the City of Abilene, Wylie Independent School District (WISD), and the City of Impact to hold a Joint Election in Certain Voting Precincts on May 11, 2013.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Texas Election Code, Chapter 271 authorizes political subdivision of the State of Texas hold elections jointly in voting precincts if it will be of benefit to the citizens and voters thereof to be served by common polling places and elections are ordered by the authorities of two or more political subdivisions to be held on the same day in all or part of the same territory.

FUNDING AND FISCAL IMPACT

The standard cost for a city election is \$29,337.00. Wylie ISD conducts early voting separate from the City of Abilene and whereas they share only 2 polling locations. The City of Impact shares 1 polling location with the City.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that Council approve by Oral Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between the City of Abilene, Wylie Independent School District, and the City of Impact.

AGREEMENT BY THE CITY OF ABILENE, THE CITY OF IMPACT, AND WYLIE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, TO HOLD A JOINT ELECTION IN CERTAIN VOTING PRECINCTS

ON MAY 11, 2013

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene ("CITY") will hold a general election for two City Council positions within the boundaries of the CITY on May 11, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Impact ("IMPACT") will hold a general election for City Council positions within the boundaries of the City of Impact on May 11, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, the Wylie Independent School District ("WISD") will hold a general election on May 11, 2013, for Board of Trustees; and,

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code, Chapter 271, authorizes political subdivisions of the State of Texas to hold elections jointly in voting precincts if it will be of benefit to the citizens and voters thereof to be served by common polling places and elections are ordered by the authorities of two or more political subdivisions to be held on the same day in all or part of the same territory; and,

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, authorizes local governments to contract with one another and with agencies of the state for various governmental functions including those in which the contracting parties are mutually interested.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Chapter 31 of the Texas Election Code, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and Sections 271.002 and 271.003 of the Texas Election Code, the Joint Election Agreement set forth below is entered into by and between the Entities acting by and through their respective governing bodies, agree as follows:

1. WISD and the CITY will share polling places during an election on May 11, 2013, in the following locations:

Precinct: 306-108-307 Zion Lutheran Church 2801 Antilley Road

(Precinct #307 WISD only)

Precinct: 406-407-408 Thomas Elementary School 1240 Lakeside Drive

(Precinct #408 WISD only)

2. IMPACT and the CITY will share a polling location during the election on May 11, 2013, in the following location:

Precinct: 203 <u>Sears Park Recreation Center</u> 2250 Ambler Ave

(Impact City Election)

- 3. WISD, IMPACT, and the CITY will use a HAVA compliant voting system (DREs) in each election precinct in which a common election is held.
- 5. The expenses of the joint election will be divided proportional between the entities having a common election. Expenses will be determined and divided based on each precinct. Each entity will bear all expenses for equipment and supplies utilized in its election.
- 6. It is agreed that all entities will contract with Taylor County Elections Administrator to provide all election services needed for these elections.
- 7. Early voting for CITY OF IMPACT, and the CITY OF ABILENE shall be conducted jointly per the election services contract with Taylor County Elections Administrator in accordance with Title 7 of the Texas Election Code.
- 8. Each entity shall be responsible to file their individual request for pre-clearance letters with the Department of Justice.

SUBJECT: Award of Bid #CB-1313, Solid Waste Services Container Maintenance Building

GENERAL INFORMATION

On January 11, 2013, the city of Abilene received bids for the construction of a new Solid Waste Services building. Six bids were received. The lowest bid was submitted by Justice Construction. The engineer, WTA Inc, after evaluating the bid submittal, recommends awarding the bid to the low bidder.

The facility is intended to replace a sixty year old, deteriorated building that is undersized and does not meet code requirements. The current buildings lack of size will not accommodate commercial trash containers and requires maintenance staff to work outdoors, regardless of weather, to perform their daily tasks, such as welding and grinding.

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

In 2008, a certificate of obligation was approved for the amount of \$425,000. Engineering Services were procured provide design and oversight management during construction. The cost to date for the engineering services was \$46,000. The low bid is \$421,000. Currently, there is \$374,730 available to support the construction effort. The remaining amount, \$46,270, will come from fund balance.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends selection of the low bid award made by Justice Construction of Abilene, Texas in the amount of \$421,000.
