SUBJECT: Approval of an Oral Resolution Authorizing the Federal Aviation Administration to demolish the original Air Traffic Control Tower (ATCT)

GENERAL INFORMATION

As part of FAA's project to build the new ATCT, FAA included funding and responsibility to demolish the original ATCT and restore the area to a green space condition. This building does block a portion of the air traffic controllers' view of Taxiway C and, therefore, is considered a potential hazard to aircraft movement in that area. The original ATCT is owned by the City and there is no planned future use of it. Any future use would likely require considerable capital investment by the City. FAA has agreed to give the ATCT's emergency generator to the City as part of this project.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

FUNDING/FISCAL IMPACT

The City will not be fiscally responsible for this project.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends City Council approve an Oral Resolution authorizing FAA to demolish the original ATCT a restore the site a green space.
