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Public notice having been duly given, the 9-1-1 Board met at 4:30 p.m. in the Basement Conference Room of City Hall.

President Gary Young called the meeting to order.

Sheriff Dieken informed the Board he is amending his request to the 9-1-1 Board for funding for two dispatchers for his department to funding for one dispatcher.

Mr. McDaniel moved to revise and approve the FY 98-99 budget for a total of \$402,110.00 to include funding for one dispatcher for the Taylor County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Russom seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. McDaniel asked Sheriff Dieken when he expects to hire the additional dispatcher. The Sheriff responded not until some time next year. Mr. McDaniel requested 911 quarterly reports be submitted from the Sheriff's office in order to monitor the workload and efficiency of the 9-1-1 dispatching service.

Mitch McLain asked Mr. Egger if there had been a firm commitment from the County to fund the other positions.

Mr. Egger stated he feels certain the County will support the request.

The Board discussed the accuracy and payment of 9-1-1 locator maps with road ranges from Maxey Sheppard. The Board consensus was for each department to verify the accuracy of the map, and sign off on their approval prior to payment being made.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:40 p.m.
