

THE LANDMARKS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS REGULAR MEETING December 8, 2020

The Landmarks Commission of the City of Abilene, Texas met in a Regular Meeting on December 8, 2020 at 4 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 555 Walnut Street. CALL TO ORDER

Ms. Lee called the meeting to order at 4:09 p.m. and declared a quorum present.

MINUTES

AGENDA ITEMS

CA-2020-05: Receive a Report and Hold a Discussion and Public Hearing on a request for a Certificate of Appropriateness for several modifications to a parking garage located at 1149 N. 2nd Street and 151 Cedar Street

Mr. Nick Watts presented the request for Certificate of Appropriateness. The applicant would like to make modifications to the exterior of a parking garage.

CA-2020-06: Receive a Report and Hold a Discussion and Public Hearing on a request for a Certificate of Appropriateness (CA) to replace 39 exterior windows of the primary residence, replace front door inset glass to be eled frosted glass, and reconstruct the rear entry door.

Mr. Nick Watts presented this request. The applicants have requested several modifications on the property as follows:

- Replace 39 windows with wood inset windows more appropriate to the time period
- Replace front door glass inset with beveled frosted glass
- Remove pet door from rear entry door and reconstruct with similar wood materials
