Data Set:

Oct 1, 2013 – Sept. 30, 2014 we have had a total (Live and Deceased intake) of 12,459
38% of these animals came from outside our jurisdiction.

2812 of the 12,459 were picked up deceased; approximately 46% from clinics, and the remaining from streets and neighborhoods. That leaves 9647 live animals, now take out the live wildlife, Owner requested euthanasia, Aggressive, and sick animals (3530) would give a live population of dogs/cats at 6117. An additional 104 died while at the shelter, so a Healthy Live population of 6013.

We humanely euthanized 5,688 for FY 2014; only 2,158 have been euthanized for Time and Space.

This is the lowest Time/Space euthanasia for this shelter.

Healthy adoptable population of 6013; we do not look at breed or age in this number, if the animal is healthy and not sick or aggressive, then it is adoptable.

Total of 4285 placed with an additional 101 wildlife releases (birds, healthy non-high risk rabies carriers).

4386 (live releases) divided by 6013 (healthy adoptable population) Animal Services is at a 73% live release rate.

Our average length of stay for an animal to be adopted has been 6.5 days; length of stay for animals which have been euthanized due to lack of space 12 days. These numbers means it takes at least 7 days for animal to be adopted and we have been able to hold adoptable animals for an average of 11 days before euthanasia.

Cat adoptions increased 47% since partnership with Petsmart. 94% of those adoptions are to new adopters. Each month we have at least one off-site adoption event with the Adoption House.
