This program is an affiliation of Service Members, Veterans and their Family Members (SMVF) dedicated to establishing camaraderie and trust with each other. They assist with navigating from the military life to civilian life and provide peer support. Equine therapy is one service that is provided that has proven to be beneficial in many ways. It promotes physical, occupational and emotional growth for many individuals not only with PTSD and TBI but depression, anxiety, and ADHD, just to name a few. Being an alternative therapy and the success it has in helping heal, it is helpful for not only Veterans, but family members, and children.

The first year of this program, we saw 506 folks. To date, for this FY, we have seen 809.
