a. Case No. 17-014 - 525 Butternut St (AKA 533 Butternut St) (OT ABILENE TIF #1, BLOCK 85, LOT 9 &N1/2 LT 8) Owner(s): Blanca Cortez

Mr. Clay Door presented this case. The staff findings and order are as follows:

Findings: The property is a public nuisance in that it is a hazard to the public health, safety and welfare and repair of the structure would be unreasonable.

Pursuant to Chapter 8; Sec. 8-554 the following conditions exist:

- (1) Inadequate Sanitation (d, e, f & l)
- (2) Structural Hazards (d, g)
- (3) Nuisance, Chapter 19, Sec.15 (b & d)
- (4) Hazardous Electrical Wiring
- (5) Hazardous plumbing
- (7) Faulty weather protection (b, c, d)

Order: The owner is ordered to demolish or appeal the order to district court within 30 days or the City may demolish.

Mr. Beard opened the public hearing.

There being no one present and desiring to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Mr. McColum made the motion to declare the property a public nuisance in that it is a hazard to the public health, safety and welfare and repair of the structure would be unreasonable. Mr. Allred seconded the motion.
