Public Comment: None


- 1. Acceptance of Minutes from March 8, 2022:** Jamie Thomas made a motion to approve minutes. Katherine Ballard seconded, with all in favor the motion carried.
- 2. Introduction and Welcome of New Board Member:** The board welcomed Mary Catom. Mary gave a brief history of herself and thanked the board members.
- 3. Citylink Update:** Wayne Kruger updated the board about the Citylink numbers and stated the increase in calls getting closer to precovid numbers. Wayne discussed the shortage of drivers stating that they are still not turning anyone away for pickups. Wayne also discussed the cancellation numbers and no shows are still high and they are working on these issues.
- 4. Discussion on Plan of Action to Promote Disability Awareness Month:** JoAnne discussed wanting to pin down some dates for October's Disability Awareness Month events. JoAnne discussed wanting to have the proclamation by October 13th, the first City Council meeting for the month.

- b. Fire alarms in bathrooms as well as out front need to be updated for hard of hearing customers.
- c. No water wheel chairs.
- d. Concession signage needs to have something for visually impaired guests.


