## • Update by staff on progress toward strategies on "recovering" capacity

- ADA certified riders using fixed route receiving free fare
  - James Oliver explained current benefit for ADA clients is reduced fare and explained that free fixed route rides for ADA clients requires city approval.
  - Mike Vandervoort elaborated on the benefit of free fixed route rides for ADA clients and that current eligibility is NOT affected.
  - ADA client Jessica Lacy asked if cost would affect current ADA riders;
- o RFP for taxi cab to help with overflow
  - Procedure was explained by James Oliver including that final draft is in legal for approval.
- Timeline for arrival of Type 2 Vans that use non-CDL Drivers
  - James Oliver updated that is still in process but TxDOT has increased the requirements.
  - Drivers of Type 2 vans will be trained using the "SMITH" system as used to train CDL drivers at CityLink.
  - Applicants who do not possess a CDL will undergo 30-day training to obtain one.
  - Type 2 vans are ADA compliant but are smaller than paratransit vans currently in use at CityLink.
  - Previous attempts have been made to recruit school bus drivers.
