Mr. McDaniel estimated an interest rate of $9\frac{1}{4}\%$ might be expected on the bonds, which would finance waterworks, drainage improvements, fire stations and street, bridge and traffic improvements.

Joe Smith, 1st Southwest Co., presented & explained the form & content of the Official Notice of Sale, Official Bid Form, and Official State ment in connection with \$6.6 million City of Abilene, Texas, General Obligation Bonds Series 1981.

Mr. Smith said that Cities in Texas may not sell bonds if the interest rate exceeds 10%, because of the law. He pointed out that the date of the bond sale is May 14, 1981, at 10:30 a.m.

Mr. Smith was directed by the Council, to use the new logo on the cover of the bond document.

After discussion, Councilman Fogle moved adoption of the resolution approving form & content of Official Notice of Sale, Official Bid Form, and Official Statement in connection with \$6.6 million City of Abilene, Texas, General Obligation Bonds Series 1981. The motion was seconded by Councilman Higginbotham. The motion carried as follows:
