The City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, met in Special Meeting, Monday, December 28, 1981, at 9:00 a.m. with Mayor Elbert E. Hall, present and presiding. Councilmen Seaton Higginbotham, Juan C. Rodriguez, A.E. Fogle, Jr. & Councilwoman Kathy Webster, present. Councilmen Dick Bowen & L.D. Hilton, absent. City Manager Ed Seegmiller, City Attorney Harvey Cargill & City Secretary Ruth Hodgins, present.

Invocation by Councilman Fogle.

Mr. Cargill said that this was the first technical step for the annexation ordinance pertaining to Quail Valley Subdivision. This meeting was necessary in order to call the public hearing and have the second and final reading on January 28, 1982.

Councilman Higginbotham moved passage of the ordinance on first reading providing for the extension of the boundary limits of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the annexation of certain territory lying adjacent to and adjoining the present boundary limits of the City of Abilene, and set a public hearing for January 28, 1982, at 9:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by Councilman Fogle. The motion carried as follows:


