The City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, met in a Pre-Council Work Session on February 13, 1986, at 8:30 A.M. in the Basement Conference Room of City Hall. Mayor David Stubbeman was present and presiding with Councilmen Gary D. McCaleb, Councilwoman Betty Ray, Councilmen Walter E. Wheat, A. E. Fogle, Jr., Welton Robinson and Harold Nixon. Also present were City Manager Jim C. Blagg, Assistant City Managers Roy L. Mr. Jerry Smith, Jerry's Campers, was present to discuss the street name change of Arnold Blvd. to Dub Wright Blvd. The new street name is scheduled to become effective upon the completion of the State Highway Department's construction on the extension of Highway 277 (F.M. 3438), which is anticipated to be in August, 1986. Mr. Smith explained the expense his business will have to incur by changing the address on several advertising brochures, calendars, and a variety of advertising material that his company supplies to patrons.

Mayor Stubbeman explained to Mr. Smith that if it was his intention to request that the street name be changed back to Arnold Blvd., the appropriate procedure is for him to apply to the Planning and Zoning Commission for such a request. No action was taken by the Council on the item.

Mr. Roy McDaniel, Assistant City Manager, briefed the Council on a donation of \$50,000 from the Abilene Housing Finance Corporation to the City of Abilene. He introduced Mr. Ray Scott, President of Abilene Housing Finance Corporation, who made a recommendation on behalf of the Corporation, to donate these funds to the City to be used for funding a position in the Housing Division for the purpose of assisting and administering the Project Self-Sufficiency. The donation will be made over a two-year period at \$25,000 increments paid to the City each year.

Mike Morrison, Community Development Administrator, explained that the Corporation will evaluate the program after one year and if they feel it is meeting its objectives, they will fund the program for a second year. If the program is not meeting its objectives, the funds will not be appropriated for the second year.

Councilwoman Ray moved to accept the donation of \$50,000 from the Abilene Housing Finance Corporation for the purpose of assisting and administering the Project Self-Sufficiency. The motion was seconded by Councilman Fogle and the motion carried.
