John Hancock, Principal Planner, briefed the Council on an ordinance considered on second and final reading - Z-9786 - Request from Buckeye American Tubular Corporation, agent, Perry Scott, to rezone from AO (Agricultural Open Space) to HI (Heavy Industrial) district, located on Ft. 18. The Planning and Zoning Commission, as well as staff, recommend approval of this request.

Mayor Stubbeman opened a public hearing to consider the aforementioned request and the following individual spoke in favor of the request.

There being no one present and desiring to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

Councilman McCaleb moved to approve the ordinance, on second and final reading, for Z-9786, as recommended by the staff. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Ray and the motion carried.

Roy McDaniel, Assistant City Manager, reviewed the proposed bond sales with the Council. It is anticipated that three sales will be necessary, one each during the Spring of 1987, 1988, and 1989. The first sale will be approximately \$3.2 million and is tentatively scheduled for a March sale. The staff will return in February, 1987, with a recommendation and the formal documents authorizing the sale. No action is necessary at the present time.

Roy McDaniel, Assistant City Manager, briefed the Council on new legislation regarding local sales tax. The staff will be communicating with Abilene's State Representatives to help refine and amend the legislation. Staff will keep the Council abreast of any new developments. No action is necessary at the present time.

Mayor Stubbeman recessed the Council into executive session in accordance with State law, Sections 2e and 2g of the Open Meetings Act, to consider pending and contemplated litigation and the appointment and evaluation of public officials.

The Council reconvened from executive session and reported no action taken.

Jonathan Graham, First Assistant City Attorney, briefed the Council on a settlement reached on the Cynthia Haile litigation. Staff recommends that the settlement offer be accepted in the total amount of \$23,250.

Councilman Fogle moved to accept the settlement offer from Cynthia Haile and authorize the City to pay damages in the amount of \$10,500 and attorney fees in the amount of \$12,750, for a total settlement amount of \$23,250. The motion was seconded by Councilman Wheat and the motion carried.

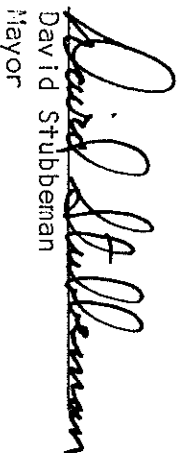
