The City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, met for a Special Council Meeting on August 23, 1995 at 10:00 a.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall for the purpose of holding a public hearing concerning annexation of the Wylie High School area. Mayor Gary D. McCaleb was present and presiding with Councilmen Paul R. Vasquez, A. Don Drennan, Russell Berry, Ray Ferguson, and Councilwoman Kay Alexander. Also present were City Manager Lanny Lambert, City Attorney Harvey Cargill, Assistant to the City Manager Debra Guerra, and City Secretary Jo Moore. Councilman Jimmy McNeil was absent.

Invocation was given by Councilman Russell Berry.

Mayor McCaleb stated the sole purpose in holding the public hearing is to begin the process specifically outlined for annexations. No action will be required, no votes will be taken. A second public hearing will be held at the regular City Council meeting August 24; and no votes or action will be taken at that hearing either.

Carl Lockett, Assistant Director of Development Services for planning, briefed the Council on the item, and stated the purposes for the public hearing are for public input on the annexation and to provide a service plan to the public, a written copy of which can be obtained from the City Secretary's office.

Mayor McCaleb opened the public hearing on the item, and the following individuals spoke:

.Don Harrison, Assistant Superintendent of Wylie Independent School District, stated appreciation for the City's approach to the annexation.

There being no one else present and desiring to be heard, the public hearing was closed.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:05 a.m.
