The City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, met for a Special Council Meeting on October 30, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall to consider nomination of candidates to the Board of Directors of the Central Appraisal District of Taylor County.

Mayor Grady Barr was present and presiding with Councilmen Norm Archibald, Kris Southward, Anthony Williams, Jimmy McNeil, John Hill, and Councilwoman Kay Alexander. Also present were City Manager Larry Gilley, City Attorney Sharon Hicks, City Secretary Jo Moore, and various members of the City staff.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

**REGULAR SESSION**

The Council reconvened from Executive Session and reported no action taken.

Councilman Archibald made a motion to approve the Resolution nominating Harold Nixon, Carl Roeder, and David Copeland as Board of Director candidates to the Central Appraisal District of Taylor County. Councilman McNeil seconded the motion and the motion carried.
