The City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas met in Regular Session on September 10, 2020, at 8:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers, 555 Walnut St. Mayor Anthony Williams was present and presiding with Mayor Pro-tem Weldon Hurt, Deputy Mayor Pro-tem Donna Albus and Councilmembers Shane Price, Jack Rentz, Kyle McAlister and Travis Craver. Presentation: Receive a Report, Hold a Discussion and Public Hearing on the Texas Ave and Dub Wright Intersection Improvements

Greg McCaffery, Director of Public Works, presented the item. This was a request from Dyess Air Force Base, as there have been many accidents at that intersection, which have caused damage to their fence. This area does not warrant a traffic signal, so staff is recommending brush clearing along Texas Avenue, and an illuminated stop sign at the intersection. The Public Works Department has enough money in their budget for the brush clearing, but not the stop sign. It is the consensus of Council to move forward with both the brush clearing and the illuminated stop sign.

Mayor Williams opened the public hearing. With no speakers coming forward, the public hearing was closed.

Presentation: Receive a Report, Hold a Discussion and Public Hearing regarding the Summary of the 2015 Traffic Signal Bond Project

Greg McCaffery, Director of Public Works, introduced Nader Ayub with Iteris to present this item. Mr. Ayub stated that the goal of this bond project was to enhance the safety and efficiency of the traffic signal operations in the city, as well as to be more proactive to citizens and staff. They have implemented new technology that links all the traffic signals together in one mainframe, and is able to detect problems with the signals before a citizen makes a complaint. This has also reduced traffic time, making it more efficient for drivers.

David Swart - stated his enthusiasm for this project, but that he did wonder why the signal at Ross Street changes for no reason sometimes.
