Discussion was held on the Project Recycle Award application received from Abilene High School. Abilene High School wants to purchase a large cross-cut confetti shredder to further their recycling program at the school. A motion was made by Ms. Smetana and seconded by Mr. Hodel to award \$500 to Abilene High School for the purchase of a cross-cut confetti shredder.

Through roll call, motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Grothaus suggested that we get progress reports from the winners that show what the money was used for and how it improved the schools.
