# Item III: Action Items

- A. 2016 17 Board Committees Two committees that were previously proposed have solidified, with members agreeing to serve. The following committees were discussed and affirmed:
  - a. Fundraising: Co-chaired by E'lisa Smetana Sylvia Holcomb
  - b. Events: Lead by a combination of Shane Johnson, Elyse Lewis, Elizabeth McAnally and Martin Garcia
- A motion was made by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Kilmer to affirm the creation of these committees and the members serving. Through roll call, the motion carried unanimously.
- B. Uses for donated disposals from roll off containers No recommendations were made, thus there was no action taken.

## **Item IV:** Non-Action Items

- A. The Governor's Community Achievement Award Mrs. Eaves invited members and guests to provide examples of community activity that would qualify for the Award's annual notebook. No examples were provided.
- B. Community Reports:
  - a. The fundraising committee discussed exploring opportunities to partner with local restaurants for donation events. There was also discussion around the idea of auctioning a fully decorated Christmas tree. Last, the idea of adding a silent auction to the St. Patrick's Day event was discussed.
  - b. The events committee reported progress on the St. Patrick's Day event. Mr. Johnson reported that he was still evaluating locations for the event. Mr. Garcia echoed the discussion of the silent auction and recommended that each board member be in charge of securing an item for the silent auction.

The board discussed the opportunity to leverage Valentines Day by pairing a Love Where You Live t-shirt with a small bouquet of flowers. More discussion on this item will take place at a future meeting.

- c. There was no report provided by the Executive Committee
- C. Coordinator's Report Mrs. Eaves reported that the board would need to settle the outstanding payable due to the City of Abilene in order to cover the balance due for the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary trees. These trees are still available for planting, but the financial transaction will need to be settled. Related to the program, Eaves reported that the city's GIS system was being updated to reflect the placed and available trees.

Keep Abilene Beautiful will again participate in the Christmas Lane event, partnering with ATEMS high school to add one (1) new feature to the display.

Beltway Baptist Church will hold their neighborhood clean up on Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup> near Stephenson park. The board has agreed previously to provide two containers, trash grabbers, and trash bags to the effort.

E. Community Partners Reports – Joe LaBlanc from the Texas Department of Transportation stated a new field coordinator would be working with the Adopt-A-Highway program.

Srini Valavala from the City of Abilene shared that \$10,000 worth of contracts had recently been awarded for street sweeping and roadway cleaning.
