#### Item III: Action Items

A. International Rescue Committee (IRC) grant application

Community members associated with the IRC, lead by Susana Lubanga, have requested \$350 to create community garden to fund tools and seeds for starting the garden.

- A motion was made by Ms. Holcomb to fund \$250 for sprouted and seed plants, and was seconded by Mr. AcAuliffe.

## B. Keep Texas Beautiful

Each year the board considers sending interest board members to the Keep Texas Beautiful conference. This year the board has agreed to cover the following expenses:

a. Conference tuition for board members

- The motion passed unanimously

#### C. AHS Grant request

A request was made by Abilene High School to purchase a branded tower garden, similar to requests received by other organizations.

- The board discussed the longevity of this program and the potential risk of continuing to award grants at a high value, with the concern that more requests will come.
- Board members discussed the options to pursue alternative sources for tower gardens.
- A motion was made by Mr. McAuliffe to table this discussion until the next meeting, seconded by Mr. Garcia
- The motion passed unanimously.

#### Non-Action Items

- A. Coordinator's Report
  - a. Lee elementary has started their campus wide Litter Free zone program.
  - b. Rain barrel give away at the ERC was well received, 50 barrels were distributed in less than 2 hours.
  - c. Keep AISD Beautiful with host a "Campus Crawl" to kick off the KTB Trash Off week.
  - d. 251 volunteers cleaned 15 areas around Abilene, including downtown
    - i. over 75 volunteers were youth
    - ii. 83 tires, 3 tons of trash were collected
  - e. Spring Clean and Tire Amnesty Day will be April 7 8 at the ERC
