PARKS & RECREATION BOARD MEETING

The Parks and Recreation Board held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, January 7, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. in the Community Services Board Room. Gail Russey called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

The Daddy Daughter Date Night will be on February 13th. The seniors annual Holiday Festival raised \$4,000.
