AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CITY
LIMITS SO AS TO INCLUDE THE PRO-
PERTY HEREIN DESCRIBED:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: WHEREAS, the owners of the following described property lying adjacent to, and adjoining the corporate limits of the City of Abilene have made application to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, requesting that said property be annexed to, and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said property being described by metes and bounds as follows:

All that certain tract or parcel of land situated in Taylor County, Texas, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the west boundary line of said N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50, Blind Asylum Lands, 1071.3 feet south of the most northerly N.W. corner of said N. W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50, said point being the southwest corner of Belmont Addition, and being in the boundary line of the City Limits of Abilene; thence N. 89° 40' E. along the south line of said Belmont Addition, a boundary line of the City of Abilene, at 1324.7 feet pass the southeast corner of said Belmont Addition and continue 1.3 feet further, a total distance of 1326.0 feet, to a point in the east line of said N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50; thence S. 0° 30' E. with the east line of said N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50 a distance of 1016.9 feet; thence S. 89° 37' W. a distance of 1328.8 feet to the west line of said N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50, ^{at a point 30 feet south of} ~~at the southeast~~ corner of Block "C" Anderson Addition; thence N. 0° 20' W. with the west line of said N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50 a distance of 1020.2 feet to the place of beginning, containing 30.0 acres of land, more or less.

SECTION II. That said above described property according to metes and bounds as herein set out, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Abilene, and an integral part of said city, and incorporated within the limits of said city.

SECTION III. That the city limits of the City of Abilene be extended as follows, so as to include the above described property, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of South 18th Street with the West line of Oak Street, a point in the present city limits; thence southward along the west line of Oak Street extended a distance of 1016.9 feet; thence south 89° 37' W. a distance of 1328.8 feet to the west line of the N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50, Blind Asylum Lands, ^{at a point 30 feet south of} ~~which point is also~~ the southeast corner of Block "C" Anderson Addition; thence northward along the west line of said N.W. 1/4 of Survey No. 50 a distance of 1020.2 feet to the Southwest corner of said Belmont Addition, a point in the present city limits.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
