AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE TEXAS TO THE MIDDLE OF CATCLAW CREEK AT A CERTAIN PLACE AS HEREIN SET OUT, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION NO. ONE: That the corporate boundaries and limits of The City of Abilene, Texas be and the same are extended as follows:

Beginning at a point, the intersection of the center line of Catclaw Creek with the South Boundary Line of South First Street, Abilene, Texas:

Thence South 85 degrees East with the South Boundary Line of South First Street to the Northeast Corner of Outlot No. Two, Block No. Seventeen of The Harris Addition to The City of Abilene, Texas:

Thence North One Hundred Feet to a stake fifty feet south from the center line of the Texas and Pacific Railroad tracks:

Thence North 85 degrees West to the center line of Catclaw Creek:

Thence up Catclaw Creek with its meanderings to the place of beginning.

SECTION NO. TWO: That all orders, resolutions, and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION NO. THREE: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as by law required.
