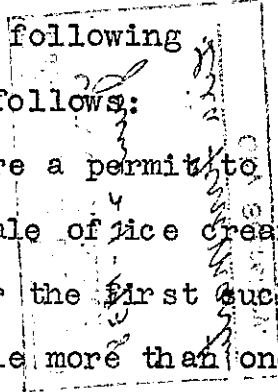


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION ONE OF AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ICE CREAM VENDORS APPROVED APRIL 1, 1921, AND RECORDED IN VOL. 1, PAGE 249, OF THE ORDINANCE RECORDS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That Section 1 of the ordinance regulating the vendors of ice cream, approved April 1, 1921, recorded in Vol. 1, page 249 of the Ordinance Records of said City, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following proviso to section one of said ordinance as follows:

" Provided that any person, may procure a permit to operate more than one such vehicle for the sale of ice cream, and the license fees shall be ten dollars for the first such vehicle and five dollars each for each vehicle more than one."



This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and the rule requiring ordinances to be read and passed at two separate meetings is hereby suspended.

Passed to first and second readings and declared adopted this the 24th day of June, A.D. 1938.
