

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION NO. 2 OF AN ORDINANCE PASSED ON THE 8TH OF JUNE, 1911 ENTITLED: "No. 2: AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PAYMENT OF FINES AND COSTS IN THE CORPORATION COURT OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE: That Section No. 2 of an ordinance passed on the 8th day of June, 1911 entitled: "No. 2: An Ordinance Regulating the Payment of Fines and Costs in the Corporation Court of the City of Abilene and Declaring an Emergency" be amended so as to hereafter read as follows to wit:

Section 2: All able bodied persons who are unable, or fail, or refuse to pay their fine, or fine and costs, assessed against them in Corporation Court of this city shall be required to perform such labor on the streets, or public highways, or public buildings, or public places, or on the public property of this city as the chief of police may require; and shall, when so actually engaged in such work, be entitled to \$3.00 per day; and when confined in the city prison shall be entitled to \$1.00 per day as a credit against such fine, or fine and costs; and when such fine, or fine and costs, have been paid at the rate above specified, such prisoners shall be released from custody.

Passed on its first reading this the 8th day of March, A. D. 1940, all Commissioners voting "aye".

Passed on its second and final reading on this the 15th day of March, A. D. 1940, all Commissioners ^{and Mayor Hair} voting "aye".
