

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A TRACT OF LAND CONTAINING 31.77
ACRES, BEING A PART OF ABILENE HEIGHTS, TO THE CITY OF
ABILENE.

Whereas, there has been presented to the Board of Commissioners a petition by residents and other persons asking the annexing of the hereinafter described land to the city of Abilene, Texas; and said Board of Commissioners having determined that it has the authority to annex same and that said petition is presented in the manner and form authorized by law, and it is deemed advisable to annex said land to said city, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the hereinafter tract of land being a part of Abilene Heights, consisting of 31.77 acres more or less, be and the same is hereby annexed to said city of Abilene, said tract so annexed being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the present city limits line in W.B.L. of Ave "E" where the S.B.L. of North Thirteenth Street extended West intersects the W.B.L. of Ave. "E":

Thence South ~~1010~~ 1010 with the W.B.L. of Ave. "E" to its intersection with the N.B.L. of North Tenth Street for corner:


Thence ¹³⁷⁰ 1370 feet with the N.B.L. of North Tenth Street to its intersection with the E.B.L. of Ave. "F" for corner:

Thence North 1010 feet with the E.B.L. of Ave. "F" to its intersection with the S.B.L. of North Thirteenth Street for corner, same point being in the present city limits line.

Thence West 1370 feet with the S.B.L. of North Thirteenth Street to the place of beginning containing 31.77 acres of land more or less.

Passed at its first reading this the 28th day of March, A.D. 1941, all commissioners voting "aye".


Passed at its second and final reading on the 4 day of April A.D. 1941, all commissioners voting "aye"
