

AN ORDINANCE SEGREGATING AND DISCONTINUING
BLOCK 24 OF SCOTT HIGHWAY PLACE ADDITION TO THE
CITY OF ABILENE AS A PART OF SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF

ABILENE:

Whereas, by an ordinance of the city of Abilene, passed on the
17th day of December A.D. 19 27 incorporating all of that tract
of land within the corporate limits of the said City, that tract of land
known as Scott Highway Place, a subdivision Lots 4 and 5 Block 17 and
all of Block 18 of the Harris Addition to the City of Abilene, which
ordinance is recorded in Ordinance Book No. 3 , page 54

of the ordinance records of said City, and it was not the intention
and said City

of the owners of said land/to incorporate, to include within said

corporate limits of said City, Block No. 24 of said Scott Highway Place,

but was the intention of the parties to except from said inclusion Block
No. 24 of said Subdivision from the land included within the corporate

limits of said City, and said Block was included within the corporate

the present owner of the property J. E. Brewer, having introduced witnesses
that said City, in including in its limits of said City, at that time

to correct said mistake, BE IT ORDAINED BY SAID BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,

That said Block No. 24 of Scott Highway Place, a subdivision of Lots Nos.

4 and 5 Block No. 17 and all of Block No. 18 of the Harris Addition to

said City of Abilene, and the same is hereby declared to be no part of
of said City, and the south and west boundary lines of said are

hereby declared to be as follows, with reference to said Scott Highway

Place, to wit: Beginning at the intersection of the south ~~boundary~~ line
boundary

of said Block No. 24, Scott Highway Place, Thence East along the south

boundary line of said Block No. 24/ to its intersection with the East

line of said Block No. 24, being the West line of Ruby Street; Thence

North with the west line of Ruby Street and the East boundary line

of said Block No. 24 to its intersection with the North line of said Block

with said

being the south line of Highway No. 80; Thence west/line to its intersection
with Elm Creek; Thence Southward with the east bank of said creek

to the place of beginning; and J. E. Brewer, the sole owner of said Block

No. 24, having waived whatever rights he may have to a refund of the taxes

paid by him to said City on said property, it is ordered that no such
taxes be refunded.
