

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OR PUTTING OF HORSES, COWS AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS INSIDE FAIR PARK WITHOUT A WRITTEN PERMIT ISSUED BY THE PARK AND PUBLIC RECREATION BOARD AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

Section 1. it shall be unlawful, from and after the final passage of this ordinance, for any person, persons, partnership or corporation to put or keep any horse, mare, cow, bull, or other domestic animal inside Fair Park, situated in said City, without having first secured a written permit issued therefor by the Public Park and Recreation Board of said City, signed by the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of said Board.

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply during the time the West Texas Fair Association or any similar organization is holding a public fair or exhibition of live stock and other exhibits in said Fair Park under authority of said Board

Section 3. Whenever any of the animals prohibited by this ordinance are found inside of said Fair Park, it shall be prima facie evidence that the owner of such animal put the same in said Fair Park and is keeping such animal in there. If the owner of such animal cannot be found; or if found and he has no written permit as required by this ordinance, the superintendent of said Park shall put such animal outside of said Park; and the policemen of said City are hereby authorized and directed to assist said superintendent in the enforcement of this ordinance.

Section 4. Any person or corporation violating ^{any of} /the provisions of this ordinance, shall on conviction be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00, and each day of keeping such animal in said Fair Park, without a written permit provided herein shall, be deemed a separate offense.

Section 5. If any part of this ordinance shall be held invalid, such holding shall not affect the valid portions thereof.
