The Mayor presented for the consideration of the Board of Commissioners an ordinance.

The ordinance was read in full by the City Secretary.
Commissioner Bacon made a motion that the Charter provision requiring ordinances to be read and passed at two separate and distinct meetings be suspended for the reasons stated in the emergency clause and that this ordinance be read and passed twice at the same meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner McWhirter. The motion was carried by the following vote:

The Mayor announced the final passage of the ordinance.

The ordinance is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO
GIVE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE INTEREST-
BEARING FIRE WARRANTS FOR SEWER PURPOSES,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY

OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized, ordered, and directed to give notice of the intention of the Board of Commissioners to pass an ordinance on the 29th day of March, 1946, to authorize the issuance of Sewer Improvement and Extension Fire Warrants in an amount not exceeding \$250,000.00, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding 2 1/2% per annum, maturing serially, the maximum maturity being not longer than Twenty (20) years from their date; that said notice be published in a newspaper of general circulation published within Abilene, Texas, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 163, Acts of the Regular Session of the Forty Second Legislature.
2. That said notice be in substantially the following

form:

"NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE
INTEREST-BEARING FIRE WARRANTS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Texas, intends on the 29th day of March, 1946, to pass an ordinance authorizing the issuance of City of

Ablilene Interest-bearing Time Warrants in an amount not exceeding \$250,000.00, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding 2½% per annum and maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the Commission, the maximum maturity or final installment to be not later than Twenty (20) years after the date of said warrants, providing for the delivery of said warrants to the holders or assignees of claims and accounts of persons performing labor and services and furnishing materials in the construction of extensions and improvements to the sewer system of the City of Abilene, Texas. Said warrants are to be issued in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 163, Acts of the Regular Session of the Forty Second Legislature.

This notice is given in accordance with an ordinance duly passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, Texas.

3. The Mayor is directed to do any and all things necessary to accomplish the publication of said notice as provided by law and to obtain proper evidence of its publication.

4. The fact that the improvements and extensions for the sewer system are necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in the City of Abilene creates an emergency requiring that this ordinance be designated an emergency measure, that the rule requiring ordinances to be read at two separate meetings be suspended, and that this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
