

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING AN ALLEY
IN BLOCK NO. 137, SAID ALLEY EXTENDING NORTH
AND SOUTH, FROM SOUTH FOURTH STREET TO SOUTH
FIFTH STREET, SAID BLOCK BEING SITUATED
BETWEEN CHINA AND ROSE STREETS.

Whereas, a petition has been presented to the Board of Commissioners,
signed by all of the owners of the property in Block No. 137 as
described in the caption hereof and said Board is of the opinion that
said alley is not needed for public use, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
ABILENE:

That the alley described in the caption hereof be and the same
is hereby closed and vacated as a public alley as is provided in
Art. 1016 of the Revised Civil Statutes (1925) of the State of Texas
and said alley shall revert to and become the property of the abutting
owners of the lots on said alley.

Passed on its first reading the 29 day of November 1946

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where
said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for
final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily
newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first
publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After
such opportunity for the public to be heard said ordinance was passed
on its second and final reading on the 13 day of December,
A. D. 1946.
