

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING
AN ALLEY BETWEEN LOT NUMBER 1, BLOCK
190 AND LOTS 1,2,3,4,5, AND 6, BLOCK
"V" JOHNSON'S SUBDIVISION OF LOT 2,
BLOCK 190 OF THE CITY OF ABILENE.

Whereas the Western Cottonoil Company and the West Texas Utilities Company being the owners of all the land described in the above caption have presented a petition praying that the alley running north and south between said lot No. 1, Block 190 and said lots 1,2,3,4,5, and 6, of Block "V" Johnson's Subdivision of Lot 2, Block 190 be closed and the Board of Commissioners of said City being of the opinion that said alley is not necessary for the public use, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That said alley be and the same is hereby vacated and closed and all rights, title, and interest of the said city of Abilene in and to said alley shall revert to and become the property of the owners of the lots adjoining said alley as provided in Art. 1016 of the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas.

PASSED on its first reading the 3 day of January, 1947

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 17 day of January, A. D. 1947.
