

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ORDINANCE,  
PASSED ON ITS FIRST READING AUGUST 8TH,  
1947 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
TO THE CITY OF ABILENE CERTAIN TERRITORY  
BETWEEN SOUTH 12TH AND SOUTH 14TH  
STREETS AND HOLLIS DRIVE AND ELM CREEK", BY CHANG-  
ING THE EAST BOUNDARY LINE OF SAID ANNEXED  
TERRITORY FROM HOLLIS DRIVE TO SANTOS STREET; AND  
ZONING SAID ANNEXATION.

Whereas, a petition has been presented to the Board of Commissioners asking for the annexation of certain property contiguous and adjacent to said city between South 12th and South 14th Streets and between Santos Street and Elm Creek; and whereas said petition has been signed by a majority of the persons residing in said territory who are qualified to vote for members of the Legislature of the State of Texas, which application has been duly proved by affidavit of one or more persons that the signatures are genuine as required by Section 4 of the City Charter;

And whereas, a mistake was made in the description of the East Boundary line of said property in said ordinance and in the Caption thereof which was passed by the Board of Commissioners on its first reading August 8th, 1947, which named Hollis Drive as the East Boundary of said property, which East Boundary line should have been Santos Street, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That said territory, described in said petition and in the Amended Caption hereof, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Abilene, said territory being described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the North Boundary Line of South 12th Street produced with the Center Line of Elm Creek for the Northwest and beginning corner of this territory; thence East with the North Boundary Line of South 12th Street to its intersection with the East Boundary Line of Santos Street; thence South with the East Boundary Line of Santos Street to its intersection with the North Boundary Line of South 14th Street for the Southeast Corner of this territory; thence West with the North Boundary Line of South 14th Street to a point opposite the East



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Passed on its first reading the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August  
1947.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After having been passed at its first reading said ordinance was amended and a notice of the time and place when and where said amended ordinance would be further considered was published in said Abilene Reporter-News the first publication being at least three days prior to the time of the hearing on said amended ordinance. Said ordinance as amended was passed on its second and final reading on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, A. D. 1947.
