

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF PEACH STREET, SAID PORTION BEING LOCATED BETWEEN SOUTH TWENTIETH STREET AND SOUTH TWENTY-FIRST STREET IN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TO JEANNETTE STREET.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene: OF COUNCIL

That the name of a portion of Peach Street, said portion of Peach Street being located between South Twentieth Street and South Twenty-First Street in the City of Abilene, be and the same is hereby changed to Jeannette Street.

Passed on its first reading the 19th day of September 1947.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the

public to be heard said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 3rd day of October, A. D. 1947.
