

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE LOTS NOS. 6, 7, 8, AND 9, IN BLOCK B, ANDERSON'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE AND ESTABLISHING ZONING DISTRICTS IN SAID ANNEXED TERRITORY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE OF 1946.

WILLIAM S. VETERANS Housing, Incorporated, a corporation of Abilene, Texas, acting by and through its President, the owners of the hereinafter described property, the same being uninhabited territory, has presented a petition asking that said territory be annexed to and included within the territorial limits of the City of Abilene, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described territory is hereby annexed and included within the corporate limits of said city, said territory being described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the east property line of the Old Cedar Gap Road (now Palm Street), said point being opposite the Southeast corner of Lot 5, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene, said point being in the present City Limit line of the City of Abilene;

Thence south along the east property line of the Old Cedar Gap Road (now Palm Street), across south 20th. street; to a point in the south boundary line of south 20th. street, said point being approximately 12 feet west from the north-east corner of Lot 1, Block 3, Norma S. Lawler subdivision of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Survey No. 50, B. A. L., Taylor County, Texas, said point being in the present City Limit line of the City of Abilene;

Thence west along the south boundary line of South 20th. street to its intersection with the west boundary line of Matador street;

Thence north along the west boundary line of Matador street to its intersection with the south boundary line of south 14th. street;

Thence east across Matador street to the point of intersection of the south boundary line of south 14th. street and the east boundary line of Matador street;

Thence south along the east boundary line of Matador street to its intersection with the north boundary line of south 20th. street;

Thence east along the north boundary line of south 20th. street to its intersection with the west boundary line of Vine street;

Thence north along the west boundary line of Vine street to a point opposite the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene, said point being in the present City Limit line of the City of Abilene;

Thence east across Vine Street to the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene;

Thence east along the south line of Lot 5, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene, said line being also the north line of Lot 6, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene, to the southeast corner of Lot 5, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene, said point being also the northeast corner of Lot 6, Block B, Andersons Addition to the City of Abilene;

Thence east across Palm street to the point of beginning. Containing


23.3 acres more or less.

Block 7, as shown on a plat hereby attached, is placed in Zone ~~F~~ in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946. The remainder of said territory hereby annexed is placed in Zone B in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946, and the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to indicate said zoning on the map of said City.

Passed on its first reading the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1948

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said Ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the

26 day of March, A. D. 1948.
