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AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN PORTION OF WEST UNIVERSITY PLACE TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AND PLACING SAID ANNEXED TERRITORY IN ZONING DISTRICT B.

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Whereas, a written application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, to annex the hereinafter described territory to the City of Abilene, which is adjoining and contiguous to the corporate limits of said City, which application has been signed by certain persons, which application has been proved by certain affidavits attached to said petition to be the genuine signatures of the persons whose names are signed thereto; the said Board of Commissioners finds that said petition has been signed by a majority of the voters, qualified to vote for members of the Legislature of the State of Texas, who reside in the territory sought to be annexed and are favorable to said annexation, said territory being portions of West University Place, an addition to the City of Abilene, Texas, said territory to be annexed being a solid block of land, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described territory be and the same is hereby annexed and included within the corporate limits of said City of Abilene so as to become an integral part thereof, and the territorial limits of said city are hereby changed so as to include said territory within said city, and said territory is hereby designated as zone B in accordance with the zoning ordinance of 1946 of said City of Abilene, the territory hereby annexed and placed in zoning district B being described by metes and bounds as follows, towit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot No. 1, Blk. 3, University Place, and addition to the City of Abilene, said point being in the present city limits of the City of Abilene;

Thence west across Clinton street to the Northeast corner of Block 1, West University Place, an addition to the City of Abilene;

Thence west along the north line of block 1, West University Place, an addition to the City of Abilene, to the northwest corner of Block 1, West University Place, an addition to the City of Abilene;

Thence north along the west line of blocks 1, 2, 3, and 4, West University Place, to the northwest corner of block 4, West University Place;

Thence north across Vogel street to a point in the north property line of Vogel street, said point being opposite the northwest corner of block 4, University Place, and said point at right angles to the north line of block 4, West University Place;

Thence east along the north boundary line of Vogel street to its intersection with the west boundary line of Grape street;

Thence south across Vogel street to the point of intersection of the south boundary line of Vogel street and west boundary line of Grape street;

Thence west along the south boundary line of Vogel street to its intersection with the east boundary line of Clinton street;

Thence south along the east boundary line of Clinton street to its intersection with the south boundary line of Sandefer street, said intersection being the point of beginning, and said territory containing 18 acres more or less.

Passed on first reading April 16, 1948.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where a public hearing thereon would be had by the Board of Commissioners and said ordinance would be considered for its final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication thereof, being at least one week prior to the time advertised for said hearing. At the time and place advertised, said ordinance was read in full and after such reading, all persons present at said hearing were given an opportunity to be heard and thereafter said ordinance was passed at its second and final reading, on the 30th day of April A.D. 48
