

ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE
NAME OF CERTAIN STREETS IN
THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR
COUNTY, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the names of the following streets be and are hereby changed
as follows:

Peach Street, as the same appears on the official plat of
Mac Böyer's replat of Blocks 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 of Böyer's
Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, a record
in the Plat Books of Taylor County, Texas, is hereby changed to
Jeanette Street, extending from South 22nd street, according to
said plat, South to the point where said street intersects State
Highway No. 30.

South 22nd Street, as shown on said plat, changed to South
21st Street, extending from Butternut Street west to Jeanette
Street (formerly Peach Street).

South 23rd Street, as shown on said plat, changed to South
22nd Street, extending from Butternut Street west to Jeanette
Street (formerly Peach Street).

South 24th Street, as shown on said plat, changed to South
23rd Street, extending from Butternut Street west to Jeanette
Street (formerly Peach Street).

South 25th Street, as shown on said plat, changed to South
24th Street, extending from Butternut Street west to Jeanette
Street (formerly Peach Street).

The fact there is much confusion as to the proper designation of the
above described streets and that there are certain petitions before the
Board of Commissioners for action at this time which necessitate the proper
designation of said streets, creates an emergency requiring the suspension
of the rule of the City Charter requiring ordinances to be read and passed
at two separate meetings of the Board of Commissioners, and said rule is

hereby suspended, and said ordinance is hereby read and passed twice at one and the same meeting of said Board.

Passed on the first reading NOVEMBER 19, 1948. Passed on the

second reading NOVEMBER 19, 1948, all Commissioners voting "Aye".
