

ORDINANCE NO. 303

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE A PARCEL OF LAND LYING IMMEDIATELY SOUTH OF THE PRESENT CITY LIMIT, BETWEEN PALM STREET AND POPLAR STREET AND EXTENDING SOUTH TO THE SOUTH BOUNDARY LINE OF WESTWAY DRIVE; SAID ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING DISTRICTS IN SAID ANNEXED TERRITORY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE OF 1946.

WHEREAS, application has been made in writing to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene for the annexation to said City of the hereinafter described property; and

WHEREAS, it appears that said application has been signed by a majority of those residing in said territory who are qualified to vote for members of the Legislature of the State of Texas, and said application is proved by the affidavit of I. L. Winkler that the signatures thereto are genuine; and

WHEREAS, it appears that said property is contiguous and adjacent to said city;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described property be and is hereby annexed and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said property being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of Lot 9, Block 1, South Park Addition of Anderson Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, which point is in the present South boundary line of said city and which said point is also in the East property line of Palm Street;

THENCE South with the East line of Palm Street to a point where said line intersects the South property line of Westway Drive;

THENCE East with the South line of Westway Drive to a point where said line intersects the East line of Poplar Street;

THENCE in a Northerly direction across Westway Drive to the Northeast corner of the Westway Drive-Poplar Street intersection and continuing North with the East line of Poplar Street to a point where said line intersects the present city limit line;

THENCE West with the present city limit line to the place of beginning.
