

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LOTS 6 to 10 INCLUSIVE IN BLOCK 11; AND ALL OF BLOCK 10 AND ADJOINING STREETS OF MAC BOWYER REPLAT OF BLOCKS 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11 AND 12, OF BOWYER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by the owner of Lots 6 to 10 inclusive in Block 11, and all of Block 10 and adjoining streets of Mac Bowyer Replat of Blocks 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, of Bowyer Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE: That Lots 6 to 10 inclusive in Block 11, and all of Block 10 and adjoining streets of Mac Bowyer Replat of Blocks 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, of Bowyer Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, are hereby annexed to and included within the territory of the City of Abilene, said territory annexed being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 11 of said Bowyer Replat and in the present City Limits Line.

THENCE South along the East boundary line of a 20 foot alley running through said Block 11, continuing South across South 26th Street to a point on the South boundary line of said South 26th Street and on the North boundary line of Block 13 of Bowyer addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

THENCE West along the North boundary line of said Block 13, continuing West across Palm Street and along the North boundary line of Block 14 of said Bowyer addition, continuing West across Peach Street to a point 5 feet East of the West line of Peach Street to a point in the present City Limits Line.

THENCE North parallel with and 5 feet East of the West line of Peach Street to a point in the present City Limits Line, which point is 5 feet East of the intersection of the West Boundary line of Peach Street and the South boundary line of South 25th Street.

THENCE East along the present City Limits Line to the place of beginning.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946, and said territory is placed in Zone "B". Passed on its first reading the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1949.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper

of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March, A. D. 1949.
