

ORDINANCE NO. 307

ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE  
CITY OF ABILENE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING  
MAY 1, 1949 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1950.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of said City duly prepared and filed his annual budget for the City of Abilene for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1949 and ending April 30, 1950, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 38 and 39 of the Charter of the City of Abilene and the provisions of Article 689a-13-15, Title 20 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, and a public hearing at which any tax payer of said City might participate was ordered by the Board of Commissioners to be held on said budget in the Chamber of the Board of Commissioners of said City on the 22 day of April, 1949, and public notice of the hearing, date and place of such hearing was caused to be given by said Board of Commissioners not less than fifteen (15) days subsequent to the time said budget was filed by the publication of such notice in the Abilene Reporter-News, a newspaper published in said City; and said public hearing was held according to said notice and all tax payers who appeared were given an opportunity to state their objections to said budget and after a full discussion by the Board of Commissioners no changes were made in said budget, *except that all salary increases provided for therein were eliminated;*  
now therefore:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

Sec. 1. That said budget for the City of Abilene for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 1949 and ending April 30, 1950, be and the same is hereby adopted and the respective sums of money therein designated for the various departments and purposes of said City for the operation and maintenance of said City be and the same are hereby appropriated for said respective purposes and it is ordered that true copies of said budget as approved be filed in the office of the County Clerk of Taylor County, Texas, and with the State Comptroller at Austin, Texas.

Sec. 2. Whereas, a necessity exists for the suspension of the rule announced in Section 32 of the City Charter providing that all ordinances shall be read and passed at two separate and distinct regular meetings of the Board of Commissioners, it is ordered that said rule be and the same is hereby suspended and said ordinance be read and passed twice at one and the same reading.

PASSED on first reading this the 25 day of April, A. D. 1949.

PASSED on second and final reading this the 26 day of April, A. D. 1949.
