

ORDINANCE NO. 313

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING SECTION #3,
ELMWOOD WEST ADDITION AND ADJOINING
STREETS, AND ESTABLISHING ZONING
DISTRICT

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by the owner of all of Section #3, Elmwood West Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF

ABILENE:

That Section #3 and adjoining streets of Elmwood West Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, is hereby annexed to and included within the territory of the City of Abilene, said territory hereby annexed being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the Southwest corner of Section #1, Elmwood west Addition to the City of Abilene, as the same appears of record in the office of the County Clerk of Taylor County, Texas, for the Northwest and beginning corner of this tract;

THENCE South 59 deg. East, 350 feet to corner;

THENCE South 64 deg. East, 180 feet to corner;

THENCE South 74 deg. East, 401 feet to corner, said corner being the Northeast corner of this tract in the South boundary line of Section #1 aforesaid;

THENCE South 23 deg. 30 minutes West, 631.3 feet to corner;

THENCE South 67 deg. East, 15 feet to corner;

THENCE South 22 deg. West, 225 feet to corner, same being the Southeast corner of this tract and being in the West boundary line of Section #2 of said Addition;

THENCE North 68 deg. 30 minutes West, 424 feet to corner;

THENCE North 62 deg. 30 minutes West, 426 feet to corner, same being the Southwest corner of this tract;

THENCE North 9 deg East, 211.5 feet to corner;

THENCE North 19 deg. 45 minutes East, 358 feet to corner;

THENCE North 28 deg. 15 minutes East, 216 feet to the place of beginning.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946, and said territory is hereby placed in

Zone "A" as the same is defined in said ordinance.

PASSED ON ITS FIRST READING this the 10th day of ~~May~~ ^{June}, 1949.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised.

After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was PASSED ON ITS SECOND AND FINAL READING on the 24th day of June, 1949.
