

ORDINANCE NO. 314

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF LEGGET DRIVE,
THE WEST END OF SOUTH 7th STREET, ELM CREEK DI-
VERSION CHANNEL AND SURROUNDING TERRITORY TO THE
CITY OF ABILENE

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene is the owner of the hereinafter described property and the Board of Commissioners of said City desires to include said property within the corporate limits of the said City, and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the City property is contiguous and adjacent to said City, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described property be and the same is hereby annexed and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said property being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the present city limit line where the South boundary line of South 7th Street intersects with the center line of Elm Creek;

THENCE in a westerly direction with the South property line of South 7th Street to a point where same intersects the East line of Legget Drive;

THENCE in a Southerly direction with the East line of Legget Drive to a point where said line intersects the North line of Section One of Elm-wood West Addition, which said point is in the present city limit line;

THENCE West with the present city limit line across Legget Drive a distance of sixty feet (60') to the West line of Legget Drive;

THENCE in a Northerly direction with the West line of Legget Drive to a point where said line intersects with the North line of South 7th Street;

THENCE East with the North line of South 7th Street to a point where said line intersects with the West bank of Elm Creek Diversion Channel;


THENCE in a Northerly and Easterly direction with the West bank of Elm Creek Diversion Channel to a point where said Elm Creek Diversion Channel West bank of the Original Elm Creek Channel;

THENCE East to a point in the center line of Elm Creek, which said point is in the present city limit line;

THENCE in a Southerly and Westerly direction with the present city limit line to the place of beginning.


Passed on first reading this 17th day of June, A. D. 1949.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a final hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in said City, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 1st day of July, A. D. 1949. All of the above described property hereby annexed is hereby placed in "A" Zone in accordance with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946.
