

ORDINANCE NO. 230

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING BLOCKS
A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, K,
L, M, N & O OF CONTINUATION
OF ARTHHEL HENSON ADDITION TO
THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR
COUNTY, TEXAS AND ADJOINING
STREETS TO THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by the owner of
Blocks A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, K, L, M, N & O and adjoining
Streets of Continuation of Arthel Henson Addition to the City
of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, to annex said property to the
City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:
THAT Blocks A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, J, K, L, M, N & O and
adjoining Streets of Continuation of Arthel Henson Addition to the
City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, are hereby annexed to and
included within the territory of the City of Abilene, said territory
annexed being described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point 20 feet East and 10 feet South of
the Southeast corner of Lot 10, Block A of Continuation of
Arthel Henson Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County,
Texas, which said point is on the North Boundary Line of
North 14th Street and in the present City Limits Line;
THENCE North 89 deg. 56' West along the North Boundary
Line of North 14th Street, 1,536.1 feet to a point 20 feet
West and 10 feet South of the Southwest corner of Lot 10, Block
L, of said Continuation of Arthel Henson Addition;
THENCE North and along the West Boundary Line of a 20
foot alley lying West of Blocks L & N and along the West
Boundary Line of Block P of Continuation of Arthel Henson
Addition, 1,867.0 feet to the Northwest corner of said Block
P and the South Boundary Line of North 19th Street;

THENCE North 89 deg. 42' East with the South line of
North 19th Street, 1,536.1 feet to the Northeast corner of
Lot 1, Block J, of said Continuation of Arthel Henson Addition
and in the present City Limits Line;
THENCE South along the present City Limits Line, 1,876.9
feet to the place of Beginning.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance
of the City of Abilene of 1946, and Blocks E & F of said addition
are placed in "F" Zone and the remainder of said Blocks are placed
in "B" Zone.

PASSED on its first reading the 10th day of November, 1949.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised.

After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the

25th day of November, A. D. 1949.
