

ORDINANCE NO. 360

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING SECTION C, ELMWOOD WEST  
ADDITION AND ADJOINING STREET TO THE CITY OF  
ABILENE, AND ESTABLISHING A ZONING DISTRICT.  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by the owner of all of  
Section C, Elmwood West Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE  
CITY OF ABILENE:

That Section C and adjoining Streets of Elmwood West Addition to  
the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, be and the same is hereby annexed  
to and included within the territory of the City of Abilene, said territory  
hereby annexed being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake in the NBL of the John Tumlinson Survey  
No. 36, 1034.5 ft. West of the NE corner for the NE and beginning  
corner of this survey;

THENCE West along the NBL of said Tumlinson Survey No. 36, 795.5  
feet to a stake set for the NW corner of this survey;

THENCE South 619.5 feet to a stake set for the SW corner of  
this survey;

THENCE East 795.5 feet to a stake set in the EBL of Leggett  
Drive for the SE corner of this survey;

THENCE North with the EBL of Leggett Drive 619.5 feet to the  
place of beginning.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of  
the City of Abilene of 1946, and said territory is hereby placed in Zone "E"  
as the same is defined in said ordinance.

PASSED ON FIRST READING THIS THE 24 DAY OF MARCH A.D. 1950.

The Board of Commissioners hereby finds that an emergency exists  
requiring suspension of the rule provided in Section 32 of the City Charter  
requiring Ordinance to be read and passed at two separate meetings of the Board
