

ORDINANCE NO. 362

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY
OF ABILENE A PORTION OF NORTH PARK,
AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, A petition has been presented to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, asking for the annexation of certain property, contiguous and adjacent to said City, which said property lies North of Ambler Avenue, East of Old Anson Road, South of Vogel Street, and West of Pine Street, and

WHEREAS, it appears and the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that said petition has been signed by a majority of the persons residing in said territory who are qualified to vote for members of the Legislature of the State of Texas, which petition has been duly approved by affidavit that the signatures thereon are genuine, as required by Section 4 of the City Charter;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described property be and the same is hereby included within the corporate limits of said City, said territory being a part of North Park Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the East boundary line of Old Anson Road where the same intersects the South boundary line of Ambler Avenue, which said point of beginning is the present North limit line of the City of Abilene;

THENCE North along the East boundary line of Old Anson Road to a point where said line intersects a West extension of the North boundary line of Anson Avenue;

THENCE East with the North boundary line of Anson Avenue to a point where said line intersects the East boundary line of Pine Street;

THENCE South with the East boundary line of Pine Street to a point where said line intersects the South boundary line of Vogel Avenue, which said point is in the present North City limit line;

THENCE West with the present City limit line along the South boundary line of Vogel Avenue to a point where the same intersects the East boundary line of Simmons Avenue;

THENCE South with the East boundary line of Simmons Avenue to a point where said line intersects the North Boundary line of University Boulevard;

THENCE West with the North boundary line of University Boulevard to a point where said line intersects the West boundary line of Grape Street;

THENCE North with the West boundary line of Grape Street to a point where said line intersects the South boundary line of Vogel Avenue;

THENCE West with the South boundary line of Vogel Avenue to its intersection with the West boundary line of Victoria Street;

THENCE South with the West boundary line of Victoria Street

to a point where said line intersects the North boundary line of an alley running East and West in Block 1, University Place

THENCE East with the North boundary line of said alley to a point where said line intersects the West boundary line of Clinton Avenue;

THENCE South with the West boundary line of Clinton Avenue to a point where said line intersects the South boundary line of Ambler Avenue;

THENCE West along the South boundary line of Ambler Avenue to the place of beginning.

Passed on first reading the ²⁴~~17~~th day of March, A.D. 1950.

The Board of Commissioners hereby finds that an emergency exists requiring suspension of the rule provided in Section 32 of the City Charter requiring ordinance to be read and past at two separate meetings of the Board of Commissioners and said rule is hereby suspended and said ordinance is hereby read and passed twice at one and the same meeting of said Board.

Passed on its second and final reading this 24th day of March, A.D. 1950 at 10:55 A.M. C.S.T.




