

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PART OF LOT 4, BLOCK 10, OVERPLACE, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, SAID ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING DISTRICTS IN SAID ANNEXED TERRITORY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE OF 1946.

WHEREAS, application has been made in writing to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene for the annexation to said City of the hereinafter described property, and

WHEREAS, a petition has been signed by all the owners of the hereinafter described property and said property is contiguous and adjacent to said City:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT OBTAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said property being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the East boundary line of Lot 4, Block 10, Overplace, an addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, which said point is 151 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Lot 4;

THENCE West parallel with the North line of said Lot 4, a distance of 350 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE North parallel with the East line of said Lot 4, at 151 feet past the North line of said Lot 4 and continuing North to the North line of South 20th Street, which said point is in the present City limits line;

THENCE East with the North line of South 20th Street to a point where same line intersects a continuation of the West line of Block 5 of said addition;

THENCE South across South 20th Street and continuing South with the West line of said Block 5 to a point 151 feet South of the Northwest corner of said Lot 5;

THENCE West across Thelma Street to place of beginning.

PASSED on first reading this the 14th day of July, A.D. 1950.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a final hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in said City, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said Ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 28th day of July, A.D. 1950. All of the above described property hereby annexed is placed

in Zone "B", in accordance with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946.


