AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE EAST ONE-HALF OF BLOCK 5, OF THE MAC BOWYER REPLAT OF BLOCKS 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, OF BOWYER ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, SAID ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING DISTRICT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ZONING ORDOF THE CITY OF ABILENE OF 1946.

WHEREAS, application has been made in writing to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene for the annexation to said City of the hereinafter described property, and

WANT OF THE PARTY

WHEREAS, it appears that said application has been signed by the owner of said property and that said property is contiguous and adjacent to said City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said property being more fully described as follows:

The East 1/2 of Block 5, of the Mac Bowyer Replat of Blocks 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 of Bowyer Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and all adjoining streets and alleys, the same being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the Southwest corner of Lot 7, Block 1, Bowyer Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, the same being in the East line of Poplar Street and being in the present city limit line;

THENCE South across South 23rd Street with the East line of Poplar Street to a point where said line intersects the South line of South 24th Street;

THENCE West across Poplar Street with the South line of South 24th Street to the Northeast corner of Lot 10, Block 8 of said Mac Bowyer Replat, which said point is in the present city limit line;

THENCE North across South 24th Street with the present City limit line to the place of beginning.

PASSED ON FIRST READING THIS THE 14th day of July, A.D. 1950.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a final hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in said City, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said Ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the

28th day of July, A.D. 1950. All of the above described property hereby annexed is placed in Zone "B", in accordance with the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene of 1946.
