## ORDINANCE NO. 393

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING DON JUAN STREET TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, A petition has been presented by the owners of the land comprising said Don Juan Street to annex said property to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

THAT Don Juan Street is hereby annexed to and included within the territory of the City of Abilene, said territory annexed being described as follows, to-wit:

BEING: A 60 foot street out of the North side of John Tumlinson survey # 36 and the South side of John Tumlinson survey # 35, Taylor County, Texas and lying North of Blocks 7 & 8, Section D, Elmwood West Addition and running from Legett Drive to Whittier St., Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene, of 1946 and is zoned as a street.

PASSED on its first reading the 2/1 day of July, A.D. 1950.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised.

After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 4th day of June A.D./950.
