

ORDINANCE NO. 463

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1. That in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, as amended, the following described property is hereby annexed to and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said territory being contiguous and adjacent to the present city limits of the City of Abilene and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the present city limits line which point is at the intersection of the South line of North 19th Street and the West line of Burger Street;

Thence West along the south line of North 19th Street to its intersection with the West line of a 15 foot alley lying immediately West of and adjacent to Blocks 23 and 24 of Arthur Sears Park Addition;

Thence North crossing North 19th Street and along the West line of said alley, continuing across North 20th Street and Ambler Avenue to the intersection of the North line of Ambler Avenue with the West line of said alley;

Thence East along the North line of Ambler Avenue and the South lines of Blocks 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of Arthur Sears Park Addition and continuing in a Southeasterly direction to the Northwest corner of Lot 21 of Steffens' Subdivision of Merchant's Pasture as shown by plat of record in Vol. T page 639 of the Deed Records of Taylor County, Texas, said point being on the prolongation of the center line of Ambler Avenue West across Sears Boulevard;

Thence South along the present city limits line thru Blocks 31 and 29 of Arthur Sears Park Addition to a point on the South line of North 19th Street where the present City limits line intersects same;

Thence West along the South boundary line of North 19th Street to its intersection with the East line of Shelton Street;

Thence North along the present city limits line and along the East line of Shelton Street to a point where said line intersects the North boundary line of North 20th Street;

Thence ^{North} with the North boundary line of North 20th Street to a point where said line intersects the West boundary line of Burger Street;

Thence South with the West line of Burger Street to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: That upon final passage of this ordinance the above described territory shall be a part of the City of Abilene, and the property situated therein shall bear its pro rata part of the taxes levied by said City and the inhabitants shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all of the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions and regulations of said City.

SECTION 3: That a public hearing be had ~~at~~ at 9:AM, March 7, 1952, in the Chamber of the Board of Commissioners at the City Hall in Abilene, Texas at which time all interested persons shall be given an opportunity to be heard in support of or in opposition to the passage of said ordinance annexing said territory.

Passed on First reading this 1st day of February 1952.

After said passage, said ordinance was published in its final form on the 6th day of February A. D. 1952, in a daily newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Abilene, which said date was at least thirty days prior to the date which said Ordinance was considered for final passage.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING this 7th day of March 1952.
