

ORDINANCE NO. 583

ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THE ALLEY LYING ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF BLOCKS 3, 4, 6 and 8 IN THE CONTINUATION NO. 2 TO THE CRESCENT HEIGHTS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE QUITCLAIM DEEDS TO THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the map or plat of Continuation No. 2 to the Crescent Heights Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, shows an alley lying along the West side of Blocks Nos. 3, 4, 6 and 8 of said addition; and,

WHEREAS, said Blocks Nos. 3, 4, 6 and 8 have been replatted and are now a part of Westwood Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and the alley as shown on the plat of Continuation No. 2 to the Crescent Heights Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, has never been opened on the ground and has never been used by the general public as an alleyway; and,

WHEREAS, Harry R. Bridge, Arch Lewis and The Baptist City Mission Board of Abilene, a Corporation, are the present owners of the property abutting said alley and said owners have requested the Board of Commissioners to close, vacate and abandon said alley for a public passageway, and to have the same deeded to the abutting property owners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That the alley shown on the West side of Blocks 3, 4, 6 and 8 of the Continuation No. 2 to the Crescent Heights Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, as shown on the map or plat of said Addition of record in Volume 2, Page 355, of the Plat Records of Taylor County, Texas, is hereby closed, vacated and abandoned as a public alley of the City of Abilene.

SECTION 2: That Mayor C. E. Gatlin be and he is hereby authorized to execute proper conveyances quitclaiming said property to the abutting property owners.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 18th day of June, 1954.
After passage of said Ordinance on first reading, it being deemed

necessary to pass this Ordinance to meet an emergency in accordance with Section 32 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, the rule requiring publication at least one week prior to a public hearing and requiring such hearing, was suspended by a vote of four members of the Board of Commissioners, and said Ordinance was read and passed on Second and final reading on the 18th day of June, 1954.
