

ORDINANCE NO. 633

ORDINANCE RENAMING THAT PORTION OF WASHINGTON STREET FROM VICTORIA STREET WESTWARD TO PARK AVENUE; NAMING THE SAME PARRAMORE STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That that portion of Washington Street which extends from Victoria Street westward to Park Avenue be and the same is hereby renamed Parramore Street.

SECTION 2: That the same shall hereafter be referred to as Parramore Street without any change in the numbers of the houses abutting on the same, and that appropriate markers shall be placed to designate the change in name.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 11th day of March, 1955.

After said passage a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 15th day of March, 1955, at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the <sup>1st</sup>~~25th~~ day of <sup>April</sup>~~March~~, 1955.
