

ORDINANCE CLOSING THAT ALLEY ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF BLOCKS 3, 4, 6 AND 8 OF CONTINUATION NO. 2 TO CRESCENT HEIGHTS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE AND LYING BETWEEN NORTH 12TH AND NORTH 14TH STREETS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE QUIT CLAIM DEEDS TO THE ADJOINING OWNERS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Westwood Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, has been properly platted as shown by plat of record in Volume 2, page 401 of the Plat Records, Taylor County, Texas, and the same constitutes a replat of Blocks 3, 4, 6 and 8 of Continuation No. 2 to Crescent Heights Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the same was fully approved by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, Texas, on February 13, 1953; and,

WHEREAS, along the West side of said Blocks 3, 4, 6 and 8 of Continuation No. 2 to Crescent Heights Addition there existed an alley 20 feet wide extending from North 12th Street northward to North 14th Street, which alley was actually closed by the replat but has not been formally closed by the City Commission as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That that alley in Continuation No. 2 to Crescent Heights Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, which lies immediately West of Blocks 3, 4, 6 and 8 of said addition and is 20 feet wide extending from North 12th Street northward to North 14th Street, as is shown in Volume 2, page 355 of the Plat Records of Taylor County, Texas, is hereby formally closed and shall no longer exist as an alley except insofar as it may be presently platted in Westwood Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, as shown by plat of record in

Volume 2, page 401 of the Plat Records, Taylor County, Texas, reference to both plats being hereby made for all purposes.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and City Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute quit claim deeds to the adjoining property owners to effectuate the closing of this alley.

PASSED ON FIRST READING, this 8th day of April, 1955.

After the passage of said ordinance on first reading, it being deemed necessary to pass this ordinance to meet an emergency in accordance with Section 32 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, the rule requiring publication at least one week prior to a public hearing and requiring such hearing, was suspended by vote of four members of the Board of Commissioners, and said ordinance was read and passed on second and final reading on the 8th day of April, 1955.
